

SENATOR KELLY: Mr. Chairmen, colleagues, the people of the 35th District and see what Senator Carpenter is doing with a...a...would be very thankful that he is continuing his tradition to open up state government in the state of Nebraska and make it available to the people of what is going on. I support the operation of the idea that all budgets and all spendings of money and collections of money should be written the way they are and should be available for public inspection if this hundred thousand dollars would help do that but I doubt that it would.

PRESIDENT: Senator Richendifer.

SENATOR RICHENDIFER: Mr. Chairman, members of the legislature I would like to draw to your attention page 2 and 3 of the budget and look at all of the direction that we ourselves put in our own bill. There are just dollar amounts, there is no direction in that.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: No, I said too much already.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter, have you closed on the issue? No closing. The question is shall the motion carry? All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? This is the Carpenter amendment have you all voted? Clerk record.

CLERK: 18 ayes, 20 nays and 11 not voting.

PRESIDENT: Motion is lost. We had a roll call vote?

CLERK: Roll call vote. 20 ayes, 22 nays, and 7 not voting. (Vote appears on page 626 of the Legislative Journal).

PRESIDENT: The motion fails. Back to Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: page 32, We are on the Nebraska State Historical Society, it is a continuation budget plus two full time equivalent people in the museum area. The natural resources commission on page 34 is a continuation with this notation that we are adding or recommending an addition of six full time equivalent full time personell in the flood plains program, on the bottom of page 35, all on conservation commission continuation, page 36 engineers and architects, continuation, join merit system agency request, top of page 37, board of examiners and land surveyors request and these are all small boards. The next one is public accountancy agency request and the next page examiners and abstractors continuation. Equal opportunity commission continuation plus one additional field representative top of page 39 continuation plus one and a half full time equivalent and the rent for western office, Nebraska Arts Council agency request, which is spelled out on lines 14-22 on page 39. Next page aging advisory committee; continuation plus two full time equivalent people, department of economic development, and there is language spelled out at the bottom of page 40 top of page 41 and specific language in the middle of page 41 and page 42, state board of land architects continuation and the investment council continuation plus one full time equivalent person for student loan administration.
