SENATOR SYAS: I don't know, it was probably taken the amendment...or probably a mistake in the amendment someplace along the line.

SENATOR MURPHY: I suppose that proper procedure would be to ask to have this bill laid over until tomorrow and have that restored or return it to Select for an amendment. I suppose that we can return it to Select for an amendment if the introducer has no objection.

PRESIDENT: Do I hear a motion to lay it over?

SENATOR MOYLAN: I have no objection to it.

PRESIDENT: Why don't you lay it over, you can work on it between now and the time we get to select file and then you can make a motion. You can make a motion to return it to Select File for a specific amendment. I so move.

PRESIDENT: OK, we will hold on to it then. Senator Murphy has a motion then on 652 to return it to select file. Lay it over. Senator Murphy we are just going to lay the bill over and then
