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means to go against some of the big interest, who are obviously against the people, then there's a knuckling under. There's a coming to heel. This body ought to be composed of men and women who are trying to climb to higher position. But unfortunately the position as Jonathan Swift said, that one assumes in climbing is also the position one assumes when creeping. It's also the position one assumes when creeping. Unfortunately when issues come before this body that relate to the welfare of the people. The masses of people. Too many assume the posture of creeping. I cannot support this bill in it's present form. I'll be frank with you. I'm going to try to talk to some of you and get enough votes to take Senator Murphy's amendment off of Select File. That would take 25 votes. That's what I intend to do. I'm going to use...I'm not going to use subterfuge. I'm not going to muddy the water. I'm not going to try to make you think words mean what they don't mean. I'm not going to lie about the contents of the bill. I'm not going to make anybody a good guy or anybody a bad guy. What I'm going to say that there are certain practices that occur in this society. There are certain over reaching that occurs. And there is no affective method to get at it now and prevent it. If this bills offers a vehicle, the only way it can do so is to strike Senator Murphy's amendment. And Senator Murphy on Select File. That's what I'm going to attempt to do. And I'm going to talk to you and see if you realize what you have done. What these merchants have gotten you to put your name on to. And for your reading and edification between the time we leave here and the time I'm going to get a chance to talk to you, I'd like to have you read the rhyme of the Ancient Mariner. It's about an individual who killed a bird which Mariner's considered sacred. Called an Albatros. It was hanged around, hung around this individual's neck. I think that the merchants have hung you with an albatros.

PRESIDENT: Read the motion on the desk.

CLERK: Mr. President, I move to indefinitely postpone 327. (Signed) Senator Proud.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Speaker Proud.

SENATOR PROUD: Well, Mr. President, I've been very quiet on this for an obvious reason. But I listened intently to the discussion. And it seems that Senator Chambers and Senator Waldon and other distinguished Senators believe this bill is a farce. It is no good. Whereas Senator Murphy didn't like the bill in it's original form. So as far as I can see, the mutation we have here, nobody wants. And I don't mind making the motion to kill, whether the motion passes or not. We appear to be in the age of consumerism. Everything for the consumer. But the statement was made on this floor that this bill is for the average consumer. Well that has to pre-suppose the average consumer is a damn fool. That he can't protect himself in any manner, shape or form. I don't believe it.

PRESIDENT: Senator Murphy, the motion is to indefinitely postpone 327. I understand that's your bill now.

SENATOR MURPHY: For those who are genuinely interested in comparing the two bills, and I guess that I'm aluding particularly to Senator Chambers. I have indexed both, by chapter and verse, with subject, and I will supply him those indexes because it will make the cross referencing much easier. Work which I had done on it. And I want him to believe in his own mind, if he
