PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. Senator Carpenter

SENATOR CARPENTER: Is not here, so I move that we pass over 682. It might be controversial.

PRESIDENT: All right, are there objections to passing over 682? Hearing none. So ordered. We will pass over it. That comes to LB 716.

CLERK: LB 716 (read)

SENATOR CARPENTER: Mr. President, all this bill does is make a discretion on the part of the Executive Board, whether we have an Executive Director or not. The present law says we shall. I move that the bill be moved to E & R for Initial. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, no nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. That brings up LB 621.

CLERK: LB 621 (read)

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Members of the Legislature, this is a relatively simple bill in as far as the amendment and the bill itself. So I'm going to let Senator Barnett explain the amendment and the bill, because explaining the amendment will be explaining the bill, so I move the adoption of the committee amendment, and I defer to Senator Barnett.

PRESIDENT: Thank you Senator Chambers. Back to you Senator Barnett.

SENATOR BARNETT: Mr. President and members of the Legislature. I've got to ask that this passed over because I just now looked at the committee amendment that is printed in the Journal and that's not the right amendment. It starts out right, but it doesn't go far enough. It's left off two lines. A little over two lines of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: Senator Barnett asking unanimous consent to pass..

SENATOR BARNETT: I'd just like to get that straightened out and I don't know how quite how to do it at this time. So we'd better pass over it until we get it straightened out.

PRESIDENT: Are there objections to passing over the bill? Hearing none. So ordered. Pass 621 to 622. Go to 622.

CLERK: LB 622 (read)

PRESIDENT: Senator Chambers

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President and members of the Legislature. No fun intended, this may turn out to be a hot issue. So I'm going to let Senator Barnett again handle it from beginning to end.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Senator Barnett.
