SENATOR CLARK: I would like to amend that motion to include Senator Duis's bill which is the same subject as Senator Kremer's. And I think they are both important.

PRESIDENT: It's already in there, Senator Clark.

SENATOR CLARK: You didn't mention...

PRESIDENT: 873, 605 and 771. To the head of General File. Now, I have several lights on. I have to know, or I have to dispatch this motion here. Now, does anybody else want to be heard on Senator Kremer's motion, which now has been amended to include 771. Let me ask this. Are there any objections to including Senator Stull's 771, in Senator Kremer's motion. Are there any objections to that? Hearing none then. So ordered. We will put in 771 in there. Senator Kremer is that all right with you? O.K. Fine. Now we are back to Senator Kremer's motion which place, does the Chair understand correctly 873, 605 and 771 at the head of General File. Correct? For what date? For Wednesday. O.K. Now, is there need for further discussion of that motion? Senator Richendifer.

SENATOR RICHENDIFER: Mr. President, I move the debate ceases.

PRESIDENT: I'm sorry I didn't catch your motion?

SENATOR RICHENDIFER: I move the debate cease.

PRESIDENT: All right, the question is, shall the debate now close? Does the Chair see 5 hands. Thank you. You are now voting whether the debate shall close. All those in favor of closing the debate on the motion vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Motion is to close debate. Have you all voted. Thank you. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 29 ayes.

PRESIDENT: The debate will now close. Senator Kremer. Senator Kremer, do you have any closing on your motion.

SENATOR KREMER: No closing, Mr. Chairman. Only to say that I have no more than a personal interest in this bill than anyone else. The proposition is, do you want to comply with the Federal Act and the date set by the act. That's the only interest I have in the bill, the same as the rest of them.

PRESIDENT: Then the motion is to bind the...Excuse me. Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: A question of Senator Kremer, if I might please. Senator Kremer, so that the body might know. Senator Kremer we're in agreement on everything aren't we? We merely want to get the two bills heard at the same time. Isn't that correct. And get the law passed before the deadline of the limitation of time.

SENATOR KREMER: We are agreed that both bills accomplish the same things, in the end, we just get there through different routes, that's all.

SENATOR DUIS: Thank you.
