

PRESIDENT: Then the motion is now, to have 873, 605 and 771 go to the top of General File for idscussion Wednesday. All those in favor of that motion which will bind the body will ovt e aye, all those opposed will vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK 27 ayes, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: So ordered then. 873, 605, 771 are at the top of General File for Wednesday's discussion. Now, we have bills the Chair understands for introduction. But befo re we get to that, Senator Waldron, is it the Chair's understanding you have an announcement?

SENATOR WALDRON: Mr. President, I would like to announce that the Miscellaneous Subjects Committee will have an Executive Session immediately on adjournment in Room 2102, and it will be very short.

PRESIDENT: Turn you light off, will you please, Senator. Thank you. Now, we have bills for introduction?

CLERK: We have a series of motion, Mr. President. Mr. President, I move for the introduction of the attached bills (Signed) Senator Schmit. (read)

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. Chairman and members of the body, I move the introduction of the bill. The bill is the growth.. the outgrowth of the Study Committee hearings on price spreading of livestock. The practices engaged in by selling the live-stock at various livestock markets. We visited with a number of people and determined that there were some gaps in those rules and regulations now not that perhaps were being enforced because of the Packers and Stockers Act. And this bill serves to close those gaps, and we hope that it will encourage a more orderly marketing of livestock in the State of Nebraska.

PRESIDENT: All right, stand by for just a minute, Senator Schmit. Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I move, Mr. President, that we suspend the rules and introduce all the 5 bills. Rather than going through the same procedure on each one of the 5 bills we can do that I presume according to rules.

PRESIDENT: Well, the Chair would understand that you can suspend the rules and then the bills could be introduced, but they have to be introduced individually. This is the Chair's understanding.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Suspend the Rules for all 5, then go over them separately.

PRESIDENT: Right. All right, then the motion before us now is to suspend the rules for the consideration of the 5 bills. All those in favor of suspending the rules to consider the 5 bills vote aye, all those opposed vote no. This is the motion tosuspend the rules to consider the introduction of 5 bills, that we have up here. It will save us from going through a lot of parliamentary procedure. The motion is just to suspend the rules to consider the introduction of 5 bi lls. That motion still takes 30 votes.
