PRESIDENT: Senator Nore.

SENATOR NORE: Mr. President, and fellow members. One of the reasons why some of the folks in my district in the legal profession are quite apprehensive about this Model Probate Code is that we're getting a lot of criticism still from the Court Reform. One of them is the salaries. I think ..I was told this morning by telephone that the Judge is getting 29,000 a year and he's only there one day a week in this particular County Seat. And the expenses are almost are getting almost as the plumber gets.

PRESIDENT: Senator Nore, we're discussing 755. Now are you all through talking about the motion? All right, Senator Fred Carstens do you want to close on your motion? No closing. Then the question is, shall LB 755 be placed on General File notwithstanding the action of the committee. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Motion is to place 755 on General File notwithstanding the action of the committee. If you support that motion vote aye, if not vote no. Once again the Chair would inquire have you all voted? The motion is to place 755 on General File. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.
