

SENATOR SKARDA: We can change it on Select File as well as we can to take it back, if you have 25 votes, I don't see any reason for calling it back.

PRESIDENT: Again, that is correct. Senator Mahoney.

SENATOR MAHONEY: Mr. President, for sake, Senator Skarda what we could do here, and I will ask the Clerk if I can have his attention. Can we Vince bring back Senator Dickinson's bill place the amendment on as the whole legislature did the other day anyway when we moved it, I'll offer the amendment and then move it right on back? Can we move it on over today?

CLERK: Yes.

SENATOR MAHONEY: We can do that.

SENATOR DICKINSON: A...a...

SENATOR MAHONEY: I want to go ahead and agree to bring Senator Dickinson's bill back place the amendment on, go through it, I'll place the amendment on, using metro, then we will vote on it and then either Senator Dickinson wins or.....my amendment wins, and then leave it go back on over. That will correct and follow this discussion.

PRESIDENT: Motion is simply to return the bill, Senator Whitney, do you want to be heard on the issue? This is just the motion to return LB813.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Mr. President, members of the legislature apparently Senator Dickinson feels that the rules are not properly taken care of here and since he feels this way it seems to me that we ought to honor his request.

PRESIDENT: Senator Fellman.

SENATOR FELLMAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, as long as we are talking about honoring and honoring Senator Syas as a...a...his long work in the field of education with the Syas community technical college, it would seem to me that we ought to consider another amendment to honor the south Omaha portion of this by calling a portion of the school to be set in the south Omaha Industrial Tract the Mahoney-Skarda South Omaha Campus. I think that possibly we made a tragic mistake last year in not tying down the changing the Hiram Scott name to the Carpenter Campus in western Nebraska and I would hate to see us compound that. I would like to know if Senator Mahoney and Senator Skarda would approve such an amendment, and if so, I would be happy to offer it.

PRESIDENT: That doesn't have too much to do with this particular motion at this time, but we can take it up if the bill gets back to General File or if you care to put that on as an amendment on Select File. Senator F. Lewis, what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR F. LEWIS: I think that that is an excellent idea Senator Fellman, usually we named it after dead statesmen if the three of them would comply I would comply.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to return LB813 to General File All those in favor of returning the bill...wait a minute
