SENATOR SIMPSON: I thought that we were going to get to it, I want to clear the record that the amendment having been put on illegally is the charge, and I would just like to get that amendment off as it is now, as part of the committee record, and if I would have to move to get it off as part of the committee record, then I so do just so that we could take it up.

PRESIDENT: Would your...would you write out the motion please and make sure that it is filed with the Clerk. That would help, then we would take care of it. Now, Senator Dickinson, for what purpose did you want to be recognized?

SENATOR DICKINSON: Well I think that is why I want to be recognized. I just wanted to say that the next step would appear obvious to get this thing in in its proper form before any more discussion can take place at all. This would be to get the committee to tell the proper people how this should be placed in the Journal and in their bill book as a committee amendment.

PRESIDENT: Check, and that is the next step Senator Dickinson the Chair's problem and the Clerk's problem & that we don't have the bill. We can't work on the bill if we don't have it.

SENATOR DICKINSON: Obviously it will have to wait until tomorrow or the next day.

PRESIDENT: Right, and we will take it up tomorrow as another motion, that is fine. Now does that clear up everything. Just a moment. Senator Duis, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR DUIS: I rise to explain something to Senator Dickinson if I might. Senator Dickinson returning a bill to General File for an amendment is not likely or not like returning a bill from select file or select file for a specific amendment. I want you to fully understand this. When that bill gets back to General File, it is subject to any amendment, any way shape or form that anybody wants to put on it. I think if I would have been you, I would have waited and put on.....until I got it clear over there and then returned it back to Select File for a specific amendment, but what you are doing right now is that you are opening that bill right open and if you think you had fun, you may
