

be doing, and I can imagine that one family, saying four or five children, four-five-six years old being hauled down to the Police Station because this is a misdemeanor and therefore a crime and I'm not so sure that children should be treated in that manner.

PRESIDENT: Now the Chair has a difficult position here because you have not returned the bill. The bill is on Final Reading and not subject to this type of debate. The motion is do you want to return the bill to Select File then you can debate it, that is fine. Senator Moylan for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR MOYLAN: Well, just a point of information to Senator Proud. This penalty clause has changed it to a traffic infraction instead of a misdemeanor.

PRESIDENT: Senator Simpson.

SENATOR SIMPSON: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I oppose the move to return the bill. I don't agree with the bill in the very first place, and I will site that we are in no way attempting to worry about the traffic safety or the bicycle. If we did we would be returning this bill to set the date back to put it into action now, instead of waiting two years.

PRESIDENT: Senator Dickinson, motion is to return the bill. Just a minute please Senator Duis. Senator Duis, for what purpose....

SENATOR DUIS: A point of order. We must only debate the motion to return not the bill itself for any part of it other than that specific amendment. I respectfully request that you slap the gavel if necessary and we cease the debate on the merits of the bill or anything else except the motion to return.

PRESIDENT: Thank you Senator Duis. Senator Dickinson.

SENATOR DICKINSON: I rise to oppose the motion to return the bill to Select File, Senator Duis. I would like to ask Senator Moylan a question if I may. First I will state that I also oppose anything that might put a seven year old on the street sweeping the gravel up or something for an infringement of not having reflectors on his bicycle pedals. OK, I have a question of Senator Moylan.

SENATOR MOYLAN: Yield.

SENATOR DICKINSON: Senator Moylan I happened or happen to be the proud owner of a brand new 10 speed bicycle. It does not have reflectorized pedals or reflectorized tires. I do not ride it at night. Are you telling...does this bill say that I can have a traffic infraction charge against me if I ride this in the day time on my own county road?

SENATOR MOYLAN: I don't believe that it designates that particularly.

SENATOR DICKINSON: My interpretation of it is that it does. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Are you all through? Senator Chambers did you want to be recognized?
