SENATOR DICKINSON: I ask a technical college area which would include all of Dodge, Douglas and Sarpy County. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: The question is shall the bill be laid over? To have the amendments printed in the Journal, that was part of your motion, Senator Dickinson?

SENATOR DICKINSON: Yes, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: All right, the question is shall the bill be laid over and the amendments printed in the Journal. All those in favor of laying the bill over will vote aye, those opposed will vote no. Chair would rule that in this instance that would take 25 votes because it binds the body to an action here. Question is shall LB813 be laid over and the amendments printed in the Journal. Have you all voted? Once again, have you all voted? Senator Dickinson what is your pleasure.

SENATOR DICKINSON: I would like to see everyone in their seats and voting, I will ask for a call of the house.

PRESIDENT: Do I hear a motion?

SENATOR DICKINSON: I so move.

PRESIDENT: Alright, Clerk will clear the board. Senator Dickinson has asked for a call of the house. The next bell please indicate your support for a call of the house. This motion is for a call of the house. A simple majority required. Motion is for a call of the house. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 19 ayes, and 16 nays.

PRESIDENT: We are under a call of the house. Next bell please indicate your presence. We are under a call of the house. Senators will please take their seats. Sergeant at Arms get on your horses. The motion is under vote is to just lay over LB813 and to print the committee amendments. Senator Dickinson, that is the motion under vote.

SENATOR DICKINSON: These thirteen people that haven't checked in under a call of the house, I think that they ought to be rounded up.

PRESIDENT: I'm sorry sir, I didn't catch...

SENATOR DICKINSON: The board says that there are 13 people who haven't registered in under a call of the house. There are not that many excused.
