

PRESIDENT: No, I don't have it.

SENATOR SIMPSON: Senator Dickinson has that if he would just look in his book. The standing committee amendment mine is right here in front of me.

SENATOR DICKINSON: The one that we are striking?

PRESIDENT: The one we are striking is in the book Senator Dickinson. Senator Dickinson, Senator Simpson has pointed out that the one we are striking is in the book. We are not considering the new one. We can not operate with that much noise and confusion. The motion before us if I may have your attention is to strike the committee amendment to LB813 that was adopted Friday. It should be in your bill book. We are not considering the amendment that has been proposed which has not been printed yet. Now, SENator Dickinson, I see you shaking your head yes. Are we on the same wave lengths? OK, now, Senator Warner is closing then on his motion which is to strike the amendment which was adopted Friday. Senator Warner, back to you.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, again the motion is to strike the committee amendment which this is the way you want it done and I immediately will offer the correct amendment that was adopted by the committee, the only difference between the amendment between the amendment that adopted Friday and the correct committee amendment is the name of Metropolitan instead of Eastern and then the other thing that occurred down in bill drafting but it was with my knowledge but I understood that it was in concurrence, and that is that the Omaha public, or the Omaha board, Community College board and the eastern college board was both served in the interim until the Governor appoints a new one. Those two things would be taken out of the committee amendment if you adopt the two motions. Then the bill as the committee advanced it and then its subject to whatever amendments that anybody wants to make. My attempt is to only get the bill to read at this point, exactly as it did from the committee.

PRESIDENT: Now Senator Stahmer, he was closing and the motion is to only strike the amendment that was adopted Friday. For what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR STAHMER: How can he close when we haven't had any debate on it?

PRESIDENT: Do you want to debate now?

SENATOR STAHMER: I would like to ask Senator Warner a question.

PRESIDENT: Fine, ask Senator Warner a question.

SENATOR STAHMER: In your interpretation of the motion that or the amendment that was adopted and printed in the book, you are changing it and I read this amendment in the book that both of them will serve in the interim. What does this amendment that you are proposing? Who would serve in the interim under the amendment that you are proposing.

SENATOR WARNER: The amendment SENator Stahmer that was adopted by the committee read that eastern would serve in the interim. The one in the....no....it is the one that is submitted up there.
