

proper representation by district on a board when in Omaha he doesn't want me to have any representation in my choice at all.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the Richendifer amendment? All right. Senator Richendifer, you may close on your amendment. Now, if the Chair can have your attention, Senator Richendifer is closing on his amendment to LB813.

SENATOR RICHENDIFER: Mr. President and members, I think Senator Syas misunderstood this. Omaha could have 5 members. There will be 3 appointed at large and I think the Governor will take this into consideration. Now, when these people come up for election, it will be a different ballgame. We cannot do it on an election process, one man, one vote. But to get the thing rolling and to have, as Senator Chambers says, representation, we're not really asking much. But on the appointed board we are asking that we be represented since we're being dragged into the Omaha district.

PRESIDENT: Question is, shall the Richendifer amendment be..... Senator Syas, he was closing.

SENATOR SYAS: Okay.

PRESIDENT: That's what I was trying to make clear and if I allow questions, we could go on and on and on. We can debate all morning.

SENATOR SYAS: Well, I just want to ask him a question.

PRESIDENT: All right, go ahead.

SENATOR SYAS: Are you being dragged into our area or do you want to go the other way?

SENATOR RICHENDIFER: Whose bill was it? It wasn't our bill.

SENATOR SYAS: You said you were being dragged in, I just wanted to know if you feel you're being dragged in.

SENATOR RICHENDIFER: In a sense, I really don't object to it. I think it's a good move but I say, it wasn't my bill, it wasn't Senator Dickinson's bill.

SENATOR SYAS: Would you rather go the other way with the other district?

SENATOR RICHENDIFER: I don't think it is very practical to be the other way, Senator Syas. But all I'm asking is to have some representation when we make the move.

PRESIDENT: The question is shall we adopt the Richendifer amendment. All of those in favor of adopting the amendment, will vote aye. All those opposed will vote no. The motion is to adopt the Richendifer amendment to LB813 on General File. The motion is to adopt the Richendifer amendment to LB813 on General File. The question is now, have you all voted?
