CLERK: Two.

PRESIDENT: Motion's been made for a call of the house. Will the Clerk clear the board please before we have that motion. We shall now have the vote for a call of the house. Those in favor, vote aye. Those opposed vote nay. All it takes is a simple majority. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 24 ayes, 12 nays, Mr. President. We're under call.

PRESIDENT: We're under call of the house. Will the Sergeant at Arms....record your presence. Will the Sergeant at Arms come out and collect the senators. Senator DeCamp, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR DE CAMP: I move the call be raised, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to raise the call. First motion was to raise the call. Those in favor of raising the call, vote aye. Those opposed, vote nay. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 10 nays to raise the call.

PRESIDENT: The call is raised. There will be a roll call vote on the original Waldron amendment on LB327.

CLERK: Roll call vote.

PRESIDENT: We're apparently having trouble with communications. We're voting on the original Waldron amendment to LB327.

CLERK: Continue roll call vote. 24 ayes, 22 nays, remainder not voting.

PRESIDENT: The motion fails. Are there further amendments on LB327?

CLERK: None. There are no further motions, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to advance LB327 from....Senator Simpson.

SENATOR SIMPSON: I ask for machine vote.

PRESIDENT: Machine vote's been called for. This means it takes 25 of votes to advance. Senator Murphy, do you wish to close on LB327?

SENATOR MURPHY: No, I simply move its advancement.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to advance LB327. Those in favor, vote aye. Those opposed, vote nay. Takes 25 votes. Senator Whitney voting aye. Have you all voted? Have you all voted?
