by the wholesaler onto the invoice, which becomes a part of the cost and that you cannot sell below that, except in an area where you may have accumulated those products the extent that they have become obsolete. In that case they can sell them for whatever they might care to sell for. Also many members have been asked about the Bottle Clubs. The Bottle Clubs would remain as they are, that they don't have to have a membership list, and they in effect have a Class C license so they become automatically as a Class C operation. I move for the adoption then with the understanding that what I've said is correct.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion and the second. Will the Legislature be at ease for just a second.

CLERK: We have to clarify what we are adopting. They are two separate amendments, Mr. President. Mr. President, the Chairman has requested that we move to reject the amendments offered by Senator Cavanaugh, which are found on page 421 of the Legislative Journal.

PRESIDENT: O.K. is that...if there is no objection we will take up this motion first, and then we will take up the motion to adopt the amendments to 616. Senator Waldron makes the motion that the committee amendments on..found in the Journal on page 413, is that right?

CLERK: 421.

PRESIDENT: 421 be rejected.

CLERK: Mr. President, they are all committee amendments. But one set were offered by Senator Cavanaugh, who is vice-chairman of the committee, and another set by Senator Waldron who is Chairman. And so Senator Waldron's motion is to reject those offered by Senator Cavanaugh found on page 421 of the Journal.

PRESIDENT: Senator Cavanaugh do you wish to be recognized?

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I assume the amendments are basically the same is that right, Senator Waldron? In Senator Waldron's absence I advance the amendments and apparently he duplicated that, so I think that's the situation.

PRESIDENT: Well, in other words you are in accord with the motion? To reject those amendments

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Right.

PRESIDENT: O.K. Senator Cavanaugh seconds Senator Waldron's motion to reject the amendments to 616 found on page 421 of the Journal. Ready for the question? All those in favor of that motion, say aye, opposed no. Motion carried and the amendments are rejected. Now Senator Waldron we are back to...

CLERK: Now Mr. President, the motion is to adopt the committee amendments offered by Senator Waldron, Chairman of the committee, which are found also on page 421 of the Legislative Journal.

PRESIDENT: Then that motion was made and who seconds that motion? O.K. the motion is made and seconded that we adopt the committee amendments to 616 found on page 421. Are you ready for the question? All those in favor of the motion say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. The amendments are adopted. Now Senator Carpenter do you want to move to advance the bill as amended.
