Vince Rossiter, Sr. Bd of Educational Lands & Funds, and a Mrs. Sharon Holyoke, State Board of Health. I move for the appointment favorable by the Legislature for these people.

PRESIDENT: All seven, instead of six.

SENATOR BARNETT: Right.

PRESIDENT: Any objection to that, if not we will take the vote.

CLERK: Senator Syas voting aye.

PRESIDENT: Have you all voted. Voting aye 29, voting nay 0, not voting 20. (Printed on page 786 of Journal.) Members are confirmed.

CLERK: Voting aye 29, voting nay 9, not voting 20. That's all I have on the desk Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Is there a motion, or shall we go to General File. Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I move we recess until 2:00.
