PRESIDENT: The Legislature please come to order. We shall have the invocation by Dr. Robert Palmer.

CHAPLAIN: Prayer given.

PRESIDENT: Roll call.

CLERK: Senator Fellman asks to be excused until he arrives. Senator Warner asks to be excused until he arrives. Senator Proud asks to be excused.

PRESIDENT: Have you all registered by your presence? Have you all registered your presence? Clerk will record.

CLERK: Quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Legislature is in session. Is there any corrections of the Journal.

CLERK: Mr. President, the Journal is without error.

PRESIDENT: The Journal will stand. Any petitions or memorials?

CLERK: None yet, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Notice of Committee hearings or reports.

PRESIDENT: Then we will go to Final Reading. Will the Senators please take their seats. The first bill is LB 228 with the Emergency Clause. Will the Clerk please read the bill.

CLERK: LB 228 With Emergency. (read)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is 'Shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached?' Those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: Voting printed on page 804 of the Journal.
