The question has been called for. Clerk will record. The motion failed.

The motion to indefinitely postpone LR 779 failed.

CLERK: We have an amendment offered by Senator Kremer to LR 779. It would add a new section to amend 37-526. Which would insert the words 'or livestock feed lot'.

PRESIDENT: Senator Kremer.

SENATOR KREMER: Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature. The statutes now provide, no hunting shall be done within 200 yd. of the farmstead. But today many of the feedlots are quite some distance away from the farmstead. So this amendments provide that no hunting shall be done within 200 yds. of feedlots where there are a great amount of cattle in some instances. These cattle are frightened, and go off feed, etc. So I move for the adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: Senator Mahoney.

SENATOR MAHONEY: It's a good amendment and should be adopted. I second it.

PRESIDENT: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: I wonder if Senator Kremer would yield to a question.

PRESIDENT: Senator Kremer yield?

SENATOR KREMER: Yes.

SENATOR WARNER: I wondering, Senator Kremer. I think everybody appreciates the problem with livestock for feedlot. I have great many neighbors that have a good many cows in the field too. They are not quite as close together as the steers. Would object to amending it to prohibited also where there are any livestock whatsoever in the fields?

SENATOR KREMER: I don't object, no.

SENATOR WARNER: I'll try to have one properly prepared, then.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to adopt Senator Kremer's amendment. We will have a voice vote. Those in favor say aye, those..excuse me. It has to be 25 votes on Select File. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote nay. Senator Whitney voting aye. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 22 ayes, 0 nays, 20 not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion is adopted.
