It has been acknowledged by the judges, the keepers of the law, the dispensers of justice, that this sitting on a court that is improperly districted, they don't belong there under the circumstances and yet they don't want to do anything about it. They want to study. They want to study what? They don't know enough their own sitting on the court to have a decision made at this time, and then how how are they going to make issued for the complex issues of law, which they don't have ten or twelve years to study. Study will result in nothing. What Senator Syas said about the Bar Association and the Legal profession in general is true. They are a do nothing, time wasting, special interest type organization, which is self serving, self seeking, and attempts to be self perpetuating in terms of their little closed shop operation. And they operate like this in every area that they contaminate, and they contaminate practically every area that they touch, and yes I'm studying to be a lawyer. But that doesn't mean I have to be like I see. I can learn how to be a lawyer, not by duplicating what I see, but by observing the pitfalls to being a good lawyer and by what I see and avoiding those things. This bill can be a step in the right direction. Understand that the legal profession is moves very very slowly. And usually after they get through moving they decide to do nothing. I think the bill ought to be raised. The issue is serious enough to be discussed. And anything that is pulled along in it's train, we should be mature enough to deal with.

PRESIDENT: Senator Stahmer.

SENATOR STAHMER: Mr. President and members of the body. To touch on one sentence, where justice is delayed is where justice denied. We have courts above the Nebraska courts. Thank God, we have Federal Courts, and people then have the ability to take their cases to the Federal Courts, and one of the chief grounds for those decisions to move to the Federal Courts is that gerrymandered districting in Nebraska. And we all..those of us who have grievances are aware of this. It only casts bad light on the state of Nebraska to perpetuate this fraud, and force people to go to Federal Courts. I move the previous question.

PRESIDENT: Senator Stahmer, there is nobody else left who wishes to speak. So the Chair will rule that Senator Fellman can close on his motion to advance to General File notwithstanding the action of the committee which was to indefinitely postpone 1033. Senator Fellman.

SENATOR FELLMAN: I will be very brief, members of the Legislature Because this debate has lasted longer than I would have expected. And I would choose to not answer Senator Syas's accusation. Because I think if he would reconsider them, he might wish to change them. Rather than that I would like to quote from Senator Syas's committee hearing. And quote from the testimony of Mr. Dunlevey, the Supreme Court Administrator on this bill who said, and I quote." I want to say also that the members of the Supreme Court are not opposed to redistricting of the present districts." Now if I had the good fortune of being in Senator Syas's living room, through the electronics..through the miracle of electronics, I was merely intending to quote what Mr. Dunlevey said in the transcript of the good Senator's committee. I would also like to add by quoting from the committee report. Prepared I assume personally by Senator Syas, it says, and I quote. "It
