

PRESIDENT: Senator Kremer.

SENATOR KREMER: Mr. Chairman, I move for the adoption of the committee amendments. All the committee amendments do is to provide who shall pay for the inspection fee. It is easy to follow and the section fee shall be paid for by all departmental inspections, manufacturing plants located outside the state of Nebraska and it provides that sub-fees shall consist of reimbursement by the manufacturer of actual departmental travel and inspections in other words, it shall determine who will pay the inspection fees.

PRESIDENT: Any discussion? Those in favor of the committee amendments say aye, those opposed say no. Committee amendments are adopted. What shall we do with the bill Senator Burbach.

SENATOR BURBACH: Mr. President, members of the legislature I move that LB826 be advanced to E & R for initial.

PRESIDENT: Senator Burbach, do you wish to explain the bill?

SENATOR BURBACH: We in Nebraska have not had a sound inspection system on our mobile homes. We have turned out by some manufacturers from other states bringing their homes here which are not sound. We...or the manufacturers of homes within the state feel as though that they would subject themselves to all inspections and this would make an inspection across the board for all mobile homes sold within the state. There was no opposition to the bill, and the committee advanced it 7 to 0 and one members being absent I move for the bill being advanced to E & R Initial.

PRESIDENT: Senator Burbach.

SENATOR BURBACH: I move for unanimous consent.

PRESIDENT: OK.

SENATOR BURBACH: I ask for unanimous consent to move the bill to E & R Initial.

PRESIDENT: Senator Barnett.

SENATOR BARNETT: Mr. President, I wonder if Senator Burbach Senator Kremer, or somebody would try and answer this question. We just passed over 643, which had to do with mobile homes now we have this one on the board. I am wondering Senator Burbach, is there any reason why we couldn't hold this one to discuss it along with 643 and....in other words I'm saying that this is 2 or 3 of the same type of bills here in effect. What do you think?

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: The only reason I pass it over was that it was Senator Simpsons bill and he was not here.

SENATOR BARNETT: I was going to do it if you wasn't. Because it had to do with trailer homes, and that is what I was asking Senator Burbach about.

SENATOR BURBACH: This one has to do with inspections and not with tie downs, and I don't see any relationship between
