

PRESIDENT: So ordered, LB887 is the next bill.

CLERK: Read LB887.

SENATOR KREMER: Mr. Chairman, I move that we pass over 887 there are several Senators that have an interest in this bill that are not present this afternoon, I think they ought to be here when we discuss it.

PRESIDENT: Pass over 887. The next bill is 934. Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: Mr. President, I would suggest that we pass over this since Senator Epke is not here.

PRESIDENT: So ordered.

SENATOR DUIS: 935 also.

PRESIDENT: Vince, pass over 668.

CLERK: Read LB757

PRESIDENT: Senator Kremer.

SENATOR KREMER: Mr. President, members of the legislature,  
(end belt #5A)

as I recall the committee amendments provide that it shall apply to cities of the metropolitan and primary class and from there on down it uses the word "where permitted". All the way down it uses where permitted. I move for the adoption of the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT: Any discussion? Senator Kremer.

SENATOR KREMER: Yes, I think that maybe you are on the wrong bill.

PRESIDENT: 757?

SENATOR KREMER: This has to do with improvement districts provides, join together for improvements in two or more districts and there were committee amendments. These are the committee amendments that I am talking about. It provides that sanitary improvement districts located in a county which has a city of metropolitan or primary class in this boundary, so it does apply to metropolitan or primary class cities. The rest is clarifying language.

PRESIDENT: Those in favor of the committee amendments.

SENATOR KREMER: Senator Dickinson, add anything to that on this bill.

SENATOR DICKINSON: I think that is right on the committee amendment anyway. It did cover all counties and someone offered the amendment to reduce it to metropolitan counties to SID's in metropolitan counties.

SENATOR KREMER. That is right.
