SENATOR LEWIS: I do, I'm apologizing for not...

SENATOR WARNER: Some schools are going to have a problem. Senator Waldron has suggested he'd attempt to put the other amendments on Select File, but if you wish to object, that fine.

SENATOR LEWIS: I want to object. And I apologize for not having doing it earlier. Simply a misunderstanding on my part. And I apologize to the members of the Legislature for wasting three or four minutes of their time.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion on the amendments to 857. Do I understand you object to taking up the bill. Senator Frank Lewis objects to taking up the bill, so the bill will lay over. There is an motion to adjourn.

CLERK: Reports read I move we adjourn, signed Senator Syas.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter, Senator Syas, is not here so

SENATOR CARPENTER: Senator Whitney has been waiting patiently on 302 and I think we ought to make.

PRESIDENT: Senator Syas would you hold your motion until he takes up. Alright Senator Syas is withdrawing his motion to adjourn, and we'll take up LB 302. Read the title, Mr. Clerk Senator Whitney will.

CLERK: LB 302 Title read. The bill has been apparently to General File, and apparently then returned to committee. There are now committee amendments by Senator Kennedy's public health committee and then there amendments to the committee amendments that are unsigned, maybe they are a part of the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT: Senator Kennedy.

SENATOR KENNEDY: Mr. President and fellow members. I move the adoption of the committee amendments. I would just like to very briefly

explain the committee amendments. Originally the bill was brought in with an amendment by the committee which brings all the counties into the bill in six different regions, and the additional amendments that were added to that would be that the elected officials that would be County Commissioners, would be the voting board. The advisory board would be selected by them. Then that the county would participate of funds of 25% and the state 75%. Then that there also would be an audit of the books. Those three amendments are the main amendments, plus the original amendment that did designate and set up out the counties. That in simple language is what the detail amendments amount to. If there
