

*(Vote on LB888 officially 4B-0-6)*

February 28, 1974

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached. All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote no. You are voting on the Final passage of LB771. Once again the Chair would inquire if you have all voted. Clerk will record.

CLERK: Read vote. 43 ayes, no nays, 6 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill has passed with the emergency clause attached. Attention please. The Final Reading of LB873.

CLERK: Read LB873. (Machine malfunction)

PRESIDENT: Senator Fred Carstens voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Fred Carstens voting aye. 39 ayes, 5 nays, 5 not voting.

PRESIDENT: All right. The bill has passed with the emergency clause attached. The Chair recognizes Senator Duis. For what purpose do you rise, Senator?

SENATOR DUIS: Mr. President, I would ask unanimous consent if the presiding officer would sign the bill now and have it hand delivered to the Governor for his signature.

PRESIDENT: Senator Duis, the Chair will comply and it only has to be correctly enrolled and that is being expedited. You can rest assured it will be moved today.

SENATOR DUIS: I would like this unanimous consent to show in the record.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Are there objections to the expedition of this bill? Senator Stull?

SENATOR STULL: Include LB771 in the same motion.

PRESIDENT: Are there objections? We can deliver them all today. Are there objections? Hearing none, so ordered. It'll be done. Attention please, the Final Reading of LB888. The assistant clerk will read the bill.

CLERK: Read LB888.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Yesterday we moved on Final Reading to instruct the clerk to read rapidly and without too much disturbance and also to permit then, suggest to the Chair that he allow the members to leave their seats if they so desired as long as they remain in the room.

PRESIDENT: For what purpose did you want to be recognized? Okay. Thank you.

CLERK: Read vote. 42 ayes, no nays, 7 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is passed. Do we have any resolutions on the desk?

CLERK: Read committee reports. LB771 and LB873 examined and enrolled.

PRESIDENT: While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I am signing LB771. Also LB873.

CLERK: The Enrolling Clerk reports that she did on this day deliver to the Governor LB1036. Signed, Barbara Jackson,
