

say no. So ordered, the bill's advanced.

SENATOR STULL: Now, I move to bring the bill back to Select File for amendment. The amendment would be to make this amendment apply only to the counties of the class of Douglas.

PRESIDENT: It's the Chair's understanding that Senator Stull's amendment applies only to the Carpenter amendment which was just adopted. Now, the motion at this particular time is to return LB646 to Select File to amend Senator Carpenter's motion which under the rules of the Legislature could not be amended while on Select File because of its being a specific amendment. Senator Stull wants to amend that so that it would apply only to cities of Omaha class.

SENATOR STULL: No, the County of Douglas.

PRESIDENT: Excuse me, Douglas class, not Omaha. Thank you, sir. The question is shall LB646 then be returned for the specific amendment as outlined by Senator Stull? All those in favor of returning the bill, vote aye. All those opposed vote no. Motion is just to return LB646 for specific amendment as outlined by Senator Stull. Thank you. Clerk will record. This is just to return the bill.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 3 nays, 19 not voting.

PRESIDENT: Okay, the bill is returned.

SENATOR STULL: Now, Mr. President and members of the Legislature. I move that my amendment be adopted and that would only amend the Carpenter motion that this apply only to Douglas County. I move the adoption of my amendment.

PRESIDENT: Now, Senator Stahmer, do you want to discuss the Stull amendment here? That's all that's under discussion is Senator Stull's amendment to Senator Carpenter's amendment. Senator Keyes, do you want to discuss the Stull amendment.

SENATOR KEYES: Yes, I'd like to ask Senator Stull a question.

PRESIDENT: Okay. Senator Stull, will you yield to a question?

SENATOR STULL: Yes.

SENATOR KEYES: Senator Stull, then this means that in no other county than Douglas County can we do anything with the salaries right now, salaries of the employees right now?

SENATOR STULL: That's right.

SENATOR KEYES: Well, Senator Stull, I have a bill and there's another bill in the Judiciary Committee that I want to take and put my county attorney as a full time county county attorney and pay him accordingly. And I certainly think that we need this bill and I can't see why you want to limit it to just Douglas County. If you will include that to include counties of 60,000 and up, I'll go along with it. But otherwise, I'd have to oppose your amendment on that ground.

SENATOR STULL: Well, Senator Keyes, if you open this wide open, then we're going to get into problems. Senator Kime needs to get this bill passed and over to the Governor's office so that they can decide in these counties between,
