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that has a population between 6,000 and 7,000 whether they're going to have a Clerk of the District Court. I think what you're trying to do in another area, you're getting in the area of whether you want to permit a county attorney to have a practice outside of the county attorney's office. And, I think that's an entirely different matter.

SENATOR KEYES: Well, it's not an entirely different matter because we cannot expect a man to perform service for the county only and not increase his salary. So if we want to get this bill going, let's go ahead and get it going. We're not going to open anything up and if the county attorney, commissioners of these counties across this state are hiding something, then maybe it needs brought out into the open. But let's get this bill right like it and get your amendment killed and go on with the bill. I need it, I really need it bad.

PRESIDENT: All right, Senator Dickinson.

SENATOR DICKINSON: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, I was disappointed this morning, my friend Senator Syas, I thought sure he would be standing up instead of me having to and say why are you willing to do something to us you aren't willing to do to yourselves. And that's exactly what this amendment would do, to impose or be privileged in Douglas County that the rest of you don't want to do. So it seems, this would seem to me to be a very odd amendment to me to be imposing on this bill now.

PRESIDENT: Now, Senator Nore. Just a minute, Senator Stull.

SENATOR NORE: Mr. President and fellow members. This is a good amendment. The conditions in the Omaha area are so much different, than they are outstate and this is going to solve a problem for them and is going to save them about \$9,000 and we're for that but it's going to sort of raise havoc with our stability of salaries outstate so let's put this amendment and go about our work.

PRESIDENT: Now, any further discussion of the Stull amendment? Senator Stull, do you have any closing? Senator Stull is closing on his amendment.

SENATOR STULL: Mr. President and members of the Legislature. Yes, I'd like to reply to what Senator Dickinson said. Now, out in a good many of these small counties, they only have one person that's filed for these offices. If we open it up and if the county board, I know in some counties that this might happen, if the county board doesn't like this particular individual, why they might cut the salary. They pass judgment on setting these salaries some time ago and I think the most of them will live with it. And, it's a little bit different kind of politics when you get in these small counties and that's why I don't want this opened up for all the counties.

PRESIDENT: Senator Nore, did you want to debate the amendment again? All right, the question is, shall the Stull amendment be adopted to LB646? All those in favor of adopting the amendment vote aye. All those opposed vote no. You're voting to adopt Senator Stull's amendment to LB646 on Select File. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 6 nays, 18 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Now, Mr. President, there's a request to bracket the bill until March 3. Signed, Senator Dickinson.
