CLERK: Report read. Mr. President I ask unanimous consent to consider 995 on March 5, (Signed) Senator Barnett.

Mr. Carpenter asks unanimous consent request that we advance those bills placed on Select File as of this date. Unless there is some reason to hold them over.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Ready for the E & R amendments.

CLERK: We have a list. Who has the list?

CLERK: Mr. President LB 647 was considered this morning and laid over. There are no amendments on it yet. It will be 975.

PRESIDENT: We are by passing 647, is that the Chair's understanding. Beginning with what then,

CLERK: 975.

PRESIDENT: Senator Cavanaugh back to you.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 975'

PRESIDENT: YOU heard the motion to adopt the amendments to 975 All those in favor of adopting amendments, please say aye, those opposed say no. Amendments are adopted.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I move that LB 975 as amended be advanced from E & R for Engrossing.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to advance LB 975 as amended. All those in favor of advancing the bill please say aye, those opposed say no. The bill as amended is advanced.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I move that 975A be advanced from E & R for Engrossing.

PRESIDENT: The motion now is to advance LB 975A for engrossing. All those in favor of advancing the bill please say aye, those opposed say no. The bill is advanced.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 739.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to ...did you say amendments. I'm sorry I was distracted.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: The motion is to adopt the amendments to LB 739
