You are voting--to add Senator Warner's E Clause effective June 1, 1974 to LB 614 on Select File at this time. Senator Dickinson, I have to have you punch the button. Somebody, Senator Anderson punch his button I believe. O.K. Thank you, Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, Mr. President on motion to adopt.

PRESIDENT: O.K. the Warner amendment is adopted, then. Are there other amendments to 614 of Select File.

CLERK: None.

PRESIDENT: Back to you, Senator Cavanaugh.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I move that LB 614 be advanced to E & R for Engrossing.

PRESIDENT: The motion now is to advance LB 614 as amended. All those in favor of advancing the bill, please say aye, those opposed say no. The bill as amended is advanced.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I move that LB 855 be advanced to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion now to advance LB 855. All those in favor of advancing the bill please say aye, those opposed say no. The bill is advanced. I think that does it, Senator Cavanaugh.

CLERK: No, there's some more now. Mr. President, we just reported in a bunch of bills, to Select File, the first 3 have amendments and the fourth one doesn't and the fifth one does. The first three have amendments, Mr. President. LB 641

SENATOR CAVNAUGH: I move the E & R amendments to LB 641.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion to adopt the amendments to 641. All those in favor of adopting the E & R amendments say aye. Those opposed say no. The amendments are adopted.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I move that LB 641 as amended be advanced to E & R for Engrossing.

PRESIDENT: Now, the motion is to advance LB 641 as amended. All those in favor of advancing the bill, please say aye. Those opposed say no. The bill is advanced.

CLERK: 864, and there are amendments.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I move the adopting of the E & R amendments to 864.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion to adopt the amendments to LB 864. All those in favor of adopting the E & R amendments. Say aye. Those opposed say no. The E & R amendments are adopted.
