SENATOR WARNER: The \$1,000 limitation?

SENATOR MURPHY: Would that apply only to the contribution of that particular candidate, or would it cover the contribution to a party, committee.

SENATOR WARNER: No, it limits any candidate or committee from receiving. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: The question is then, do you want to adopt the committee amendments. All those in favor of adopting the amendments please say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered. The committee amendments are adopted. Are there other amendments to the bill.

CLERK: None, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Warner, back to you.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move that the LB 877 be advanced.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion now, of the bill? Question is, excuse me. The question is shall LB 877 then as amended be advanced from General File to E & R Initial. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. At this point you are voting on the advancement of LB 877. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 1 nay, 23 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. That brings up for General File then for consideration LB 1024. Senator Epke's bill. Clerk will read the bill.

CLERK: LB 1024 Title read.
