that the committee amendments with the Duis amendment adopted shall be adopted at this time.

PRESIDENT: Alright, now is there further discussion of the committee amendments as amended by the Duis amendment? If you are in favor of the committee amendments as amended say aye, opposed say no. So ordered. The Committee amendments are adopted as amended by the Duis amendment. Are there other amendments now to the bill?

CLERK: No further amendments Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Duis do you want to explain the bill?

SENATOR DUIS: I would move LB660 be advanced from General File to E & R Initial. This legislation is there just to authorize the department of aging to receive funds from the federal and state government should they be available and sets this up so that they might also use some school buses that excluding counties of over 150,000 population.

PRESIDENT: Senator Syas, do you have further questions. Will you please push off your light then. Thank you. Senator Stull do you have a question of Senator Duis.

SENATOR STULL: Mr. President, members of the legislature, I would like to ask Senator Duis a question. Senator Duis, I notice that there is a fiscal impact on this that says \$410,000, now Senator Duis...I was....

SENATOR DUIS: Senator Stull that was an incorrect one and they should have delivered to you this morning, I'll give you one if it isn't there, that there is no fiscal impact whatsoever. The \$416,000 was a possible impact that the department of aging had figured should they get federal and state funds and such and there is really nothing here that shows nothing from the Department, or rather from the fiscal staff.

SENATOR STULL: OK, Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Now, is there further discussion of LB660 as amended? Then the question is shall LB660 as amended be advanced from General File to E & R Initial. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Bill is advanced.

CLERK: Mr. President, we have a request to move LB905 back to General File for an amendment signed, Senator Mahoney. This is the bill that we just advanced.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Mahoney.

SENATOR MAHONEY: Mr. President, I make a motion to move it back to explain the amendment. The amendment that I was lax in that I didn't have it up in or on the desk, I didn't think
