

appropriations committee recommended that will beef up the capital construction department of the department of administrative services maybe we can get a handle on this construction so we don't stock pile a lot of money that is simply not spend. So as far as I am concerned, those who have problems in the animal science area, that money that they need to proceed would be there in our recommendations.

PRESIDENT: Now the Chair understands that it would be easy to range far and wide on the issue before the body but the question really is or the motion is to direct the fiscal staff to assemble and distribute to the members financial projections. Now Senator Carpenter. that is really the only issue before the body.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Well Senator Lewis will you again break down what you are asking for.

PRESIDENT: Senator Lewis.

SENATOR LEWIS: Yes sir, by yesterday's a paper I read the information that....

SENATOR CARPENTER: Not the paper, what do you want? The hell with the paper.

SENATOR LEWIS: As I was saying, are you finished?

SENATOR CARPENTER: Not if...

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter let him respond please.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I will.

SENATOR LEWIS: Go ahead, I have a lot of time.

SENATOR CARPENTER: So have I.

SENATOR LEWIS: This is going to go on all day.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Could be.

SENATOR LEWIS: I suspect that you are right.

SENATOR CARPENTER: You'll...

SENATOR LEWIS: Well Mr. Chairman what I a was asking is that first of all the projections for growth income be made available to use which is probably the most important factor. Now the projections up until I read yesterday, was that a 10% level. Now I understand that they are projecting a 15%. I think that they should give us their projections or income and they should make available to us the justification of those incomes or a.. a..projections and they should make available to us what the expenditures are. Now I understand that there are 260 or 282 million what-ever it is, and we should have a chance to analyze the income projections versus the projected expenditures up to this point. Which I think is a reasonable approach to analyzing budgets and expenditures. That is what I am asking for.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Thank you, now I can understand that the staff can guess and use their judgments in the projections of revenues. As long as this body will take them only as a projection and as a guess and the best information is now
