

PRESIDENT: The motion is to raise the Call. All those in favor of raising the call, vote aye. All those opposed vote no. The motion is to raise the Call. Thank you. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 12 nays to raise the Call.

PRESIDENT: Call is raised. We'll read the tally on the original vote.

CLERK: 21 ayes, 22 nays, 6 not voting.

PRESIDENT: LB692 does not advance then. That moves up to General File for consideration LB815.

CLERK: I have a committee report on the desk.

PRESIDENT: Read the report.

CLERK: Read committee report. LB646 replaced on Select File as amended. This was an expedited bill previously. It's proper to take it up at this time.

PRESIDENT: Senator Cavanaugh, could we ask you to help us on LB646. We have amendments to the bill and it's an expedited bill. We need to move it off of Select File.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I move adoption of amendments to LB646.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to adopt the amendments to LB646 on Select File. All those in favor of the motion please say aye. Those opposed say no. Amendments are adopted.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I move LB646 be advanced to E & R for Engrossing.

PRESIDENT: Now, you've heard the motion to advance the bill as amended. All those in favor of advancing the bill from Select File please say aye. Those opposed please say no. Ayes have it, so have it, the bill's advanced. Thank you, Senator Cavanaugh. That's all. Now, General File debate of LB815. Put the number on the board please. Thank you.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB815 was previously read on February 26. It was laid over at that time. We now have, we have to consider the committee amendments. We also have a DeCamp amendment to the committee amendments. Would you like me to read the amendments, Mr. President?

PRESIDENT: I think you'd better so we can refresh our memory. Senator Carpenter, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR CARPENTER: (inaudible) the amendment those that introduced explain it.

PRESIDENT: Well, Senator Goodrich, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR GOODRICH: The committee amendment is a bill now and it takes up 21 pages so if you want to read that, it's going to take a while.
