

telling them obviously we're better able to run their business than they are. I think we ought to come out of the woodwork on it and explain to them emphatically without hiding behind the fact in order to get a state aid bill, this is what we have to do. That's all it does.

PRESIDENT: All right, any further discussion of the motion? Question is shall the Lewis amendment be adopted? All those in favor please say aye. Those opposed say no. Wait a minute, what do we have, Senator Dickinson, what's your problem?

CLERK: On page 675 of the Journal.

PRESIDENT: The Lewis amendment is found on page 675 of the Journal. All right, the question is then shall the amendment be adopted. Those in favor vote aye. Those opposed vote no. You're voting on the adoption of the Lewis amendment, what is it, found on 675?

CLERK: 675 of the Journal.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Voting on the adoption of the Lewis amendment. To LB984. The amendment is found on page 675. Question is have you all voted? You are voting on the Lewis amendment found on page 675 to LB984. Have you all voted? All right, Clerk will record.

CLERK: 9 ayes, 18 nays, 22 not voting.

PRESIDENT: Motion fails. Are there other amendments to the bill?

CLERK: Yes, Mr. President, we have a further amendment from Senator Whitney printed in the Journal on page 801.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Whitney.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Mr. President, members of the Legislature. What I'd like to do there is to put in the same figures that Senator Warner has on LB722. And as a consequence instead of what is written in the Journal, instead of the 375, it would be \$400. And in place of 750 remain the same and instead of 900 it would be \$850. And in place of \$1,200, it would be \$900. Therefore, it has the same insured need figures as Senator Warner has in LB722. Mr. Clerk, have you noted those changes?

CLERK: No. Probably go through them one more time.

SENATOR WHITNEY: In other words, instead of \$375 in (1), it would be \$400 for kindergarten pupils; \$750 per pupil in grades 1 through 6; \$850 per pupil in grade 7 and 8; and.....

\$900 per pupil in grades 9 through 12. So I'm putting in the same figures that Senator Warner has in LB772. Now, this would be the insured needs and this would be the
