PRESIDENT: The motion is to adopt the amendment to LB 972. All those in favor of the adoption of the amendments please say aye, those opposed say no. The amendments are adopted. Senator Carpenter.'

SENATOR CARPENTER: Does this bill have the emergency clause on it?

PRESIDENT: Stand by. No.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I move that we attach the Emergency Clause here. This is a Child Care Center Bill.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter has asked for the addition of the emergency clause to LB 972. If you support that motion vote aye, if not, vote no. Senator Carpenter has proposed adding the Emergency Clause to LB 972 on Select File. Adding the Emergency Clause to LB 972. Still takes 25 votes. Thank you. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, 23 not voting.

PRESIDENT: O.K. The motion carries the emergency clause is added.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I move that LB 972 be advanced to E & R for Engrossing.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion now to advance LB 972 as amended. All those in favor of the advancement of the bill please say aye, those opposed say no. 972 is advanced.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I move the advancement of the E & R amendments to LB 654.

PRESIDENT: If you are in favor of adopting the amendments to LB 654 please say aye, opposed say no. So ordered. The amendments are adopted.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I move that LB 654 as amended be advanced to E & R for Engrossing.

PRESIDENT: Now there is a motion to advance LB 654. If you are in favor of advancing the bill please say aye, opposed say no. The bill is advanced.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I move the advancement of the E & R amendments to LB 826.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to adopt the amendments to LB 826. All those in favor of the motion please say aye, those opposed say no. The amendments are adopted.
