SENATOR MAHONEY: The problem is Senator Goodrich is that and I have to say this Mr. President, all we're doing is bringing this bill and forward and back and forward, and it's languaging and it seems like it's just a great delaying tactic with little pidduly amendments. I don't think the amendment is that necessary.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Senator, print the amendment in the Journal and the bill remain where it is until we can read it into the amendment in the Journal.

PRESIDENT: What is your pleasure, Senator Goodrich?

SENATOR GOODRICH: Fine, if I can get the mic going. O.K. Senator Dickinson, is that all right with you?

SENATOR DICKINSON: Well, yes, that's all right, but I'd like to question Senator Goodrich, for a moment too. I'd like to question I think a erroneous statement, may I do that please?

SENATOR GOODRICH: In the interest of not delaying things,...

SENATOR DICKINSON: I'm not delaying very much areound here very much, Mr. President, I would like to have a few words if I could please.

PRESIDENT: Go ahead.

SENATOR DICKINSON: Senator Goodrich, there is an effective board, and Senator Mahoney, I want you to listen you and I are on the same side of this, at one stage of this game. There is an effective board, the joint board of the existing two technical college areas now will be the governing board until the Governor appoints a new one, so I agree with Senator Mahoney, I really don't know the reason, or what prompted this, but it seems to be unnecessary and really superfluous.

PRESIDENT: Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR DICKINSON: Am I correct in saying there is an effective governing board? And there is an effective date of the merger in the bill?

SENATOR GOODRICH: There is an effective date of the transfer of the assets, liabilities and personnel, that immediate. There is an immediate transfer during the school term. For example; if we just wait until July 1 '74, which is the
