SENATOR GOODRICH: It says within 30 days after the affective date of this act the Governor shall appoint a new area board for the Metropolitan Community College, which appointment shall be made so as to get, etc.

SENATOR DICKINSON: You are reading from the amendment. The original bill states that the two boards, the existing areas shall be the governing board during the interim period. There is no inlimbo, there is a governing board provided in the bill at all times.

SENATOR GOODRICH: It still doesn't disrupt the fact that we're changing it during the middle of a school year, when we should actually change it at the end of the school year, that's the really main emphasis.

SENATOR DICKINSON: I don't think the bill needs to be moved back, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Richendifer, did you give up. Senator Richendifer, did you give up. O.K. The motion is to pass over the bill, and print the amendment in the Journal. Are there objections to that? Do you object? All right, then the motion. Someone has to make a motion then. Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Is the motion pending.

PRESIDENT: Well just a minute. Maybe the Chair has misunderstood. We have bypassed the motion then to bring it back, we'll just go ahead and...well...

SENATOR CARPENTER: I just move we reject, Senator Goodrich's amendment.

PRESIDENT: Well, let's vote it down or something, if we don't want it. We still have the motion before us and the bill has to be brought back so. The first motion would be to return LB813 to Select File for specific amendment and let's take care of the matter. Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR GOODRICH: It doesn't ~~have~~ to be brought back, it doesn't have to do anything. I'll just withdraw the amendment.

PRESIDENT: All right, the amendment is withdrawn. Any other amendments on the desk.

CLERK: None, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: We will read the reports and then we are ready for Senator Keyes motion. Senator Keyes is your motion on there, do you want to make from there.

CLERK: There is a unanimous consent request to print some amendment to LB127 in the Journal from Senator Barnett

PRESIDENT: Are there objections to printing the amendments. Then so ordered.

CLERK: Reports read. A motion on the desk from Senator Schmit.
