PRESIDENT: Senator Whitney asking for Call of the House. Clerk will clear the Board. The next bell, please indicate your support of Call of the House. Senator Whitney has moved for a Call of the House. Have you all voted that are going to vote? All right, Clerk will record.

CLERK: 18 ayes, 12 nays.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries. We're under Call of the House. Chair would like to respectfully ask the senators to take their seats please and at the next bell, please indicate your presence. Senator Waldron voting aye on the original vote.

CLERK: Senator Waldron voting aye.

PRESIDENT: Gentlemen, we're under Call of the House. Please take your seats.

CLERK: Senator Hasebroock voting aye.

PRESIDENT: The original vote is support Senator Whitney's amendment found on page 801 of the Journal on LB984 on General File.

CLERK: Senator Kime voting aye.

PRESIDENT: Senator DeCamp voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Simpson voting nay.

PRESIDENT: Senator Simpson voting no.

CLERK: Senator DeCamp voting aye.

PRESIDENT: Senator Mahoney, Fellman, Cavanaugh, we're under Call of the House. Gentlemen, I have to enforce the rules of this Legislature and that is that you please take your seats. Now, Senator Stahmer voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Stahmer voting aye.

PRESIDENT: Senator Mahoney voting no.

CLERK: Senator Mahoney voting no.
