money necessary to be refunded to them, from the state general fund for the loss of revenue because of the homestead exemption, then they would have from November the 30th to May the 30th to file a second request the defect or for that clerical error. This is what this bill will do. It is important to the homestead exemption act as we now have it and this is a fine vehicle to put it on, it was not considered prior on the other bill, so I move for the adoption of the amendment on 942.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to adopt the amendment. The Burbach amendment. Any discussion? It will take 25 votes. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Have we all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays and 21 not voting.

PRESIDENT: Bill or amendment is adopted. Senator Cavanaugh.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move that 942 as amended be advanced.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to advance 942. Those in favor say aye, those opposed say no. Bill is advanced.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President...

PRESIDENT: We are ready to go back to 629. Will you read the amendment please? Senator Keyes has asked for unanimous consent to withdraw his amendment. Now the motion to adopt the E & R amendments.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I move that LB629 be advanced to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to advance 629. Those in favor say aye opposed no. Bill is advanced.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: There isn't anything else up there is there?

CLERK: Motion on the desk Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: I think that that concludes Select File. Clerk will read the motion.

CLERK: Read motion regarding LB822.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to unbracket LB822 on Select File. Senator Duis did you wish to speak to that point?

SENATOR DUIS: No, I just wanted unanimous consent to unbracket it, although the amendment I have for it isn't necessary so I was just going to ask to have it unbracketed so that I could advance it back to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT: Any objections? If not so ordered.

SENATOR DUIS: I move that LB:822 be advanced to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to advance LB822, is there any discussion? Those in favor say aye, those opposed say no. Bill is advanced.

CLERK: OK, we are now back to the specific amendment of Senator Murphy's on LB327.
