PRESIDENT: Senator Maresh.

SENATOR MARESH: Mr. President, members of the legislature, these bills are the bills that one bill LB1049 allows claims against the state and LB1050 allows them and we want both of these for hearings so that we would hear the un-paid claims and if we do allow some, we want to have the bill that allows them to be amended and send out on General File, I so move.

PRESIDENT: Unanimous consent.

SENATOR MARESH: Unanimous consent.

PRESIDENT: Anyone object? So ordered. Anything else Mr. Clerk on the desk?

CLERK: Notice of committee hearing regarding LB1050. Did you want 1049 on there too Senator Maresh? For March 13 and March 14th at 1:00.

PRESIDENT: Senator Syas.

CLERK: Unanimous consent to be excused Thursday afternoon and all day Friday, signed Senator F. Lewis.

PRESIDENT: Senator F. Lewis has asked to be excused. Any objections? So ordered. Anything else on the desk? Senator Clark.

SENATOR CLARK: Mr. President, I would like to be excused Wednesday, a...a..Friday noon.

PRESIDENT: SENator Clark has asked permission to be excused Firday noon?

SENATOR CLARK: Yes, Friday noon.

PRESIDENT: Any objections? So ordered.

CLERK: I have a motion to recess until 2:00 p.m.

PRESIDENT: There is a motion to recess. SENator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Mr. President, Are we on General File yet? I move that we take up LB1028.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter moves that we take up LB1028. Is there a second? This is the first bill on General File, LB1028.

CLERK: Read LB1028

PRESIDENT: There a...a...Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: There is an amendment on the Clerk's desk

CLERK: I have an amendment from....

SENATOR CARPENTER: Let me say to the body that this is an amendment which would or was put on your desk yesterday. This indicates that the amendments that we are now proposing to 1028
