CLERK: It has six names on it.

SENATOR SCHMIT: It's a committee bill, Mr. President, and I think Senator Maresh's name should be on the bill. It was left off inadvertently and I did not notice it before I turned the bill in. The page the bill, perhaps just did not catch him at his desk and therefore, it should just be a procedural thing. It's a committee bill, his name should be on the bill.

PRESIDENT: The Chair would rule that he could just put his name on the bill. Unanimous consent under the circumstance. Are there any objections? So ordered.

SENATOR CARPENTER: He says to advance to E & R for Initial.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to advance LB1028. Senator Duis, did you have a point of order? Motion is to advance the bill. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote nay. Senator Whitney voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Whitney voting aye.

PRESIDENT: Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 34 ayes, no nays, 15 not voting to advance.

PRESIDENT: The bill's advanced. Next bill LB692.

CLERK: Senator Murphy wants to pass over LB692.

PRESIDENT: Senator Murphy asked unanimous consent to pass over LB692. Any objections? If not, so ordered. LB593. Senator Kelly.

SENATOR KELLY: Mr. President, members of the Body. I unanimously or request that we bracket LB953 for one week.

PRESIDENT: Any objections? So ordered. Next bill LB957.

CLERK: Read LB957. There are committee amendments from Senator Kennedy's Public Health and Welfare Committee. There is also an amendment from Senator Schmit to those standing committee amendments which we should consider first.

PRESIDENT: Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: The amendment which you referred to is the corrective amendment. The standing committee amendment called for the term of 60 days rather than 90 days but in the typing, the typist did not insert the words 60 in all the proper places and so my amendment up there does insert the word 60 for 90 in the proper places and I will....it's a corrective amendment to make it work it has to be in there, and if you will adopt my amendment, then I will explain the standing committee amendments. I move it's adoption.....
