PRESIDENT: Well not yet because the motion by discussion is the adoption of the DeCamp amendment as found on page 940 of the Journal. That is what we are speaking to at this time.

SENATOR FELLMAN: Mr. President, I would like to inquire of the Chair, whether Senator Duis requires unanimous consent or not?

PRESIDENT: Let us go back to the amendments. Lets get the amendments adopted then we will come back to this part of the discussion. We are on the DeCamp amendment explained by him on page 940 and he has made the motion to adopt the amendments unless you have further input Senator DeCamp, I would be ready to take the vote. Those in favor of the amendments on page 940, please say aye, those opposed? The DeCamp amendments are adopted. Back to you Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DE CAMP: Mr. President, I move that the overall amendments be adopted now.

PRESIDENT: Motion to adopt.

SENATOR DE CAMP: The committee amendments as amended by my amendment.

PRESIDENT: These are the amendments found on the General File books on your desk, is that correct? Have you all heard the motion? Those in favor say aye, those opposed? Motion to adopt carries. Before you continue Senator DeCamp, the Chair would like to recognize visitors to the chamber this morning. First of all from Webster County, Senator Anderson's district, 27 ladies from the county extension club in Senator Kelly's district 12 senior students from North West High School with their instructors. From Lincoln Cathedral School 40 fourth grade students in the south balcony with their teachers. They are represented by Senator Marsh. To all of you we extend greetings from the Nebraska Unicameral. The issue under discussion at this time and is the much talked about the probate bill. Senator DeCamp do you have any further input? We have adopted all of the amendments.

SENATOR DE CAMP: One final amendment and I have talked this over with the Judiciary Committee. There were some errors in draftsmanship, the names of the judiciary committee members were inadvertently left off and I move that the names of the judiciary committee members be added to the bill since it is such an important bill and has so much input and work by the judiciary committee members.

PRESIDENT: All right the request or the motion I should say is to add the names of the judiciary committee to LB364 I believe that under the rules at this point that it requires 30 votes and a machine vote. Those in favor of the Judiciary Committee adding the names to 354 please vote aye, and those opposed vote nay. The Chair votes aye. We need 30 votes to add the names of the judiciary committee members to LB354. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays and 19 not voting.

PRESIDENT: All right, the names will be added. Now we are back to the bill. Before we get the bill returned to the
