

LB736, 960, 625

March 8, 1974

PRESIDENT: Ready for Final Reading. Just the one bill, LB736. Clerk will read the bill.

CLERK: Read LB736.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, shall the bill pass. Those in favor vote aye. Those opposed vote nay. Voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Whitney voting aye.

PRESIDENT: Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: Read vote. 39 ayes, 0 nays, 10 not voting.

PRESIDENT: LB736 is passed. Are there any other things on the desk, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: None, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: We're ready then for Select File. The first bill LB960. Senator Cavanaugh. Are you ready, Senator Cavanaugh? I can't hear you. You'll have to push your black button. I think it's on now.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: The amendments were already adopted on LB960, were they? I move that LB960 as amended be advanced to E & R for Engraving.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to advance LB960. Those in favor vote aye. Those opposed say no. Bill's advanced. LB625.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: These aren't in the same order in the Journal.

CLERK: Page 973.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I move the adoption of E & R amendments to LB625.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to adopt the amendments to LB625. Those in favor say aye. Those opposed no. The amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Okay, now, Mr. President, we have an amendment offered by Senator Stull to amend LB625. Clerk read corrections.

PRESIDENT: Senator Stull.

SENATOR STULL: Mr. President and members of the Legislature. This bill calls for the mileage for county officials to be raised to 15¢. There's another bill that's coming along to amend the statutes so the state officials.....
