SENATOR KEYES: Yes, it is.

PRESIDENT: It can't be on pending legislation, I'm sorry.

SENATOR KEYES: It's on two bills that are held in his committee if that's pending legislation. It will be if we can get them out of committee.

PRESIDENT: I'm sorry but you can't talk on pending legislation in this Legislature until the bill's up.

SENATOR KEYES: Up where? Please explain yourself, Senator Whitney, I'd like to know how I could get to ask Senator Luedtke a question.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Why don't you come and talk to me?

PRESIDENT: Just walk down 40 feet and talk to him.

SENATOR KEYES: Senator Whitney, that would do no good so far as the thing I'm going to ask him about because I want the other senators of this Legislature to know what is happening.

PRESIDENT: Well, you can move to bring the bill to the floor notwithstanding the action of the committee. That's all you can do. Okay, we start on LB870. Clerk will read the title of the bill.

CLERK: Of what? Of what?

PRESIDENT: LB870.

CLERK: LB870 coming up. LB870 introduced.....Senator Richendifer wants to be recognized.

PRESIDENT: Senator Richendifer.

SENATOR RICHENDIFER: Mr. Chairman, I'd like to ask this bill be passed over until Monday. This is Senator Lewis' bill. There are amendments for it that have to be adopted and he's not here. I think he's excused today.

PRESIDENT: You're asking unanimous consent to pass over LB870. Have you asked for this to be passed over before? Well, this is okay. The bill's passed over. Now we go to the next bill LB692.

CLERK: Mr. President, it is my understanding that Senator Murphy would like to lay over LB692.

PRESIDENT: Senator Murphy, is this your bill? Have you asked this bill to be laid over before?

SENATOR MURPHY: Yes, sir.

PRESIDENT: Then somebody else is going to have to ask for it to be laid over. It goes to the bottom of the pile. Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Mr. President, I'll request that this bill be passed over and left right where it is. Just passed over for today.

PRESIDENT: Any objections? So ordered. Next bill's LB997. Senator Marvel, is he here? Are there any amendments on the
