SENATOR KEYES: I've been told by Mr. Peters that it will run anywhere from one million three hundred thousand dollars in the vicinity of that much, above what Senator Whitney and Senator Marvel have proposed. I can give you the figures here if you want them, they are quite elaborate. And you can figure it out.

PRESIDENT: We will take the vote. Have you all voted? Senator Keyes.

SENATOR KEYES: To talk about something that's going to affect hundreds or thousands of...

PRESIDENT: You have closed, Senator Keyes. If you want a Roll Call Vote or something.

SENATOR KEYES: NO., I'm going to ask for a call of the house, and a Roll Call Vote both.

PRESIDENT: You want a Call of the House. Senator Keyes wishes a call of the house. Take a vote. Clear the board, Vince, and We are now voting on a Call....

CLERK: O.K. Senator Syas voting aye.

PRESIDENT: Anyone else wishes to vote. Tabulate the vote.

CLERK: 9 ayes, 18 nays for a Call of the House.

PRESIDENT: A Call of the House is denied.

SENATOR KEYES: I still want a Roll Call Vote. I want the people to be actually on record of how they are voting for state employees for this state. Whether they believe it or not.

CLERK: Voting aye 13, voting nay 26, not voting 10.

SENATOR CARSTENS: I move the Call be raised.

CLERK: We never went under call.

SENATOR CARSTENS: I thought we were.

SENATOR KEYES: No, the Call lost.

CLERK: The next amendment, Mr. President is offered by Senator Carpenter on page 29, line 23 (read)

SENATOR CARPENTER: Mr. President, I move for the adoption of the amendment. It doesn't cost any more money. It only authorizes the ETV Commission, and if they so desire to subscribe to the Nielsen Area in order to attempt to determine the number of listeners that ETV has in the State of Nebraska. Never before have they had any idea the number of people who might be listening to the program. This has been on the air for a number of years, and I think that at least for one year if they so desire with this authority that they can have the Nielsen poll taken to determine the listening audience in the State of Nebraska. I'm...it doesn't cost anymore money. It comes out of the money they already have. I move for the adoption of the amendment.
