PRESIDENT: Any objections to Senator Stull withdrawing his amendment. If not so ordered.

CLERK: O.K. Now we have the Whitney amendment simply to strike the first sentence in section 5, page 4.

PRESIDENT: Senator Whitney do you want to talk on this amendment?

SENATOR WHITNEY: I want to be agreeable on this. And I see no problem here, and if we need to..if we need to make an amendment, and we can do it on Select File. I'd like to get this bill moved up. I don't want to be the cause of not getting this bill moved.

PRESIDENT: Any other discussion on the Whitney amendment? If not all those in favor of the Whitney amendment to the Maresh amendment signify by say aye. Contrary no. The amendment has been adopted.

CLERK: There are no further amendments pending to the Maresh amendment. So it in it's tattered form is ready for adoption.

SENATOR MARESH: WE adopt them now. I make a motion to adopt them now? I so move.

PRESIDENT: Any discussion on the Maresh amendment? If not, all those in favor of the Maresh amendment signify by saying aye, contrary no. The Maresh amendment is adopted.

CLERK: O.K. There are no further amendments, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Maresh b ack to you.

SENATOR MARESH: Mr. President, now the bill itself, here the statement itself for the purpose removes language which does not pertain to an election such where it shows at General elections. Set the dates for meeting and coincides with the dates for taking office and provides for a section of the Chairman of the board within the framework of the elected board. And 32-232 clarifies the language used in sections pertaining to the lists of voters book rather than poll book. And it removes the language stating that a candidate may not have his name printed on a ballot or series of ballots more than once at the same election. And the removal of language needed because of an attorney General's opinion. I understand that the people that run for an RD Board are also run for School Board Elections etc. And also provides the procedure for the removal of names for Governor and Lt. Governor who jointly petition their names on a ballot in case of death of one or both candidates, prior to the printing of the ballots. It sets out specific officers to be placed on an abstract of vote delivered to the State Chairman of each political party. It removes the language stating that an elective officer shall vacate his office to which if elected to anyother office, removal of language needed because of an Attorney General's opinion. They remove the words "state railway" and replaces the word with "public service" and section 8 a new section sets out the factors used in determining qualified voters at school district elections. It clarifies the language in the code that we use in the challenge of voters, votin in school district elections, and Section 10 sets out the fee to be paid by the Class 3 school districts to the county for condensing the elections.
