The Public Building Safety Committee can adopt anything it wants. And what they do is follow these codes the same as you would have with any type of code go give them an outline of what to adopt. And that way we place it in their hands if that was what you was asking.

PRESIDENT: All right, Senator Whitney do you care to respond.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Mr. President, I think if you use the word may, instead of the word shall, then Senator Barnett what you have just said would be correct. But when you say they shall implement those codes.

SENATOR BARNETT: Yes, I think you've got a good point. Do you want to move that, or I would. It doesn't make any...I don't think Senator Marsh would care about that.

SENATOR WHITNEY: You go ahead and move it, then.

SENATOR BARNETT: O.K., I'd like to...would it be proper to try to amend that at this time, Section 13 after the word committee, the public building safety advisory committee, lets replace the word shall with may.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion, are you in agreement. Do you need to discuss that, Senator Marsh, are you in agreement. All right, the question is, do you want to adopt the Barnett amendment, then to the Marsh amendment. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. You are voting to adopt the change of one word in Senator Marsh's motion as made by Senator Barnett. This is a motion that would change one word in Senator Marsh's amendment, as offered by Senator Barnett. Changing from shall to may, Section 13. Senator Barnett is amending Senator Marsh's motion by one word. Senator Barnett.

SENATOR BARNETT: We are going to have a call of the house here. We have to twenty five votes, is that right.

PRESIDENT: Yes, that's correct.

SENATOR BARNETT: Amended to adopt it. I think there is probably a lot of them in the rotunda right now, but if we could we are going to have a Call of the House, to have 25 because this would be a compromise that's on the bill. Necessary change.

PRESIDENT: Senator Barnett has offered a motion which change one word in Senator Marsh's amendment to LB602 on Select File. I think the change is from shall to may. He needs 25 votes for that change. Thank you, Clerk will record.
