25 ayes, 0 nays, the remainder not voting.

PRESIDENT: All right, the Barnett amendment to the Marsh amendment to 602 on Select File has been adopted. Is there a need for further discussion of the Marsh amendment. Senator Marsh, are you all through with your...Excuse me. Senator Duis do you want to discuss the amendment.

SNEATOR DUIS: Mr. President, I want to check here. I'm being...I'm a little concerned about this type of amending on select File. I'm wondering if not, Senator Marsh should not return this to General File because we are no longer with the Specific Amendment. I'm...just for your benefit Senator Marsh because apparently you have more than one amendment here.

SENATOR MARSH: Senator Duis. Senator Duis.

PRESIDENT: Senator Marsh.

SENATOR MARSH: The reason this was done, was so we could strike the original amendment that so we could adopt this as one complete amendment. And I think the only problem now would be the shall which has been changed to may.

SENATOR DUIS: I noted ~~that~~ there is probably going to be more than one attempt to do something there, and Senator Barnett, I believe you had something. I'm doing this for your benefit because you are at 25 votes here, and if you are back at General File, then you don't require the 25 votes. And I'd just questioning of the Chair whether or not this bill could not be asked to be returned to General File so it can be amended without the 25 votes, and so the amendment will not be specific.

PRESIDENT: That's up to the person offering the amendment. It's perfectly all right with the Chair what you choose to do. Wherever you choose to amend it. But so far the Chair doesn't see any irregularity with what has been proposed. That's a specific amendment here to the bill, and it's the Chair's understanding that when a bill is ascending that that particular kind of a motion can be amended on Select File except that it takes 25 votes. The Chair understands you...

SENATOR DUIS: If that's your decision, that's fine.

PRESIDENT: The Chair understands you being sympathetic with the mover here. Perhaps the Chair should ask, are there other amendments to the bill. Senator Barnett do you have other amendments to the bill. Are there any other amendments to the bill, on the Clerk's desk? Senator Burbach do you have an amendment to the bill?

SENATOR BURBACH: Mr. President, I do have an amendment, I was didn't realize it would be taken up this soon. I just got the amendment this morning, and we are working it in to a proper position, on the amendment that Senator Marsh is not talking about. And that..I would like to get that incorporated in to this bill sometime as it goes along the board.
