SENATOR STULL: I move the amendments...the E & R amendments to 1024 be adopted.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to adopt the E & R amendments to 1024. All those in favor of the motion please say aye. Those opposed say no. The amendments are adopted.

SENATOR STULL: I move that the bill be advanced as amended.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion now to advance 1024. All those in favor of that motion please say aye. Those opposed say no. 1024 is advanced.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion now to advance the bill. If you are in favor of advancing 942 please say aye. Those opposed say no. The bill is advanced.

SENATOR STULL: I move the E & R amendments to 327 be adopted.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion to adopt those amendments All those in favor of adopting the E & R amendments to 327 please say aye. Those opposed say no, the amendments are adopted. Back to the Clerk. Opps...wait a minute. Do we have an amendment. False alarm, all right.

SENATOR STULL: I move that the bill as amended be advanced to E & R for Engrossing.

PRESIDENT: Now the motion is to advance LB 327 as amended. All those in favor of advancing the bill, please say aye. Those opposed say no. 327 is advanced.

SENATOR STULL: I move the E & R amendments to 616 be adopted.
