CLERK: Voting aye 14, voting no 30, not voting 5.

PRESIDENT: The motion to indefinitely postpone is lost. Are there other motions now on 616.

CLERK: None.

PRESIDENT: All right, Senator Stull.

SENATOR STULL: I move that 616 be advanced to E & R for Engrossing as amended.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion to advance LB616 as amended. All those in favor of advancing the bill please say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered 616 is advanced.
