Is there further discussion necessary on that? The question is, shall the bill be returned. You are voting now to return the bill. All those in favor of returning the bill, vote aye. All those opposed vote no. This is the motion to return LB983 to Select File for a specific amendment, that would be to add the emergency clause. It takes 25 votes to return the bill. Motion is return LB983 to Select File to add the emergency clause. Have you all voted? Thank you. Whoops, now we've had a malfunction. Now, the question is if you support the return of LB983 to Select File for specific amendment to add the emergency clause vote aye. We had a malfunction, please vote again. You are voting to return LB983 to Select File to add the emergency clause. We got to this point once before. Thank you. Clerk will record. This is just to return the bill.

CLERK: 25 ayes, Mr. President, on motion to return.

PRESIDENT: Very good, the bill is returned.

CLERK: Now, Mr. President, I move the adoption of specific amendment without the emergency clause, signed, Senator Carpenter.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I so move.

PRESIDENT: All right, the question is do you want to adopt the E clause to LB983 on Select File. All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote no. Motion is to adopt the emergency clause to LB983 on Select File. Senator Carpenter is looking for 25 votes to add the emergency clause to LB983. Thank you, Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, no nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Emergency clause is added.

CLERK: Now, the motion is to advance the bill.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to re-advance the bill as amended. Those in favor of re-advancing the bill say aye. Those opposed say no. So ordered, the bill as amended is re-advanced. We had a motion this morning on what...LB763? Something else doing there? Okay. Take them in order, however they come.

CLERK: I have a whole stack of them. Mr. President, I ask unanimous consent to unbracket LB865 on Select File and advance it. Signed, Senator Anderson.

PRESIDENT: All right, Senator Anderson, ready for your motion on LB865.

CLERK: E & R amendments have previously been adopted, the Syas amendments have been adopted and then it got bracketed.

PRESIDENT: Senator Anderson in the chamber? What is your pleasure.

SENATOR ANDERSON: Mr. President, I just move it be advanced to E & R for Initial?

PRESIDENT: Well, are there objections on bracketing the bill?
