

CLERK: 25 ayes, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted. Are there other amendments to the bill?

CLERK: None.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Senator Marsh.

SENATOR MARSH: I move we advance from Select File to E & R for Engraving.

PRESIDENT: You heard the motion to advance LB602 as amended. All those in favor of advancement of the bill, please say aye. Those opposed please say no. So ordered, the bill's advanced. What other motions do we have there on Select File?

CLERK: Mr. President, we have a motion....that's all apparently on Select File.

PRESIDENT: Senator Richendifer had one, I think, on LB763 this morning.

CLERK: I'm sorry, it is here, Mr. President. I ask unanimous consent to unbracket LB763 on Select File and adopt the amendments and LB763 had previously been considered on Select File. The amendments, E & R amendments were adopted. Senator Richendifer offered the amendments which are found on page 682 of the Legislative Journal, 520 of the Legislative Journal and now there are some additional ones amending those.

PRESIDENT: Some additional ones what?

CLERK: Amending those.

PRESIDENT: All right, Senator Richendifer.

SENATOR RICHENDIFER: Mr. President, I move we reject the amendments on page 520 whatever those are. And these....the amendments on 682, is it?

PRESIDENT: Yes, sir.

SENATOR RICHENDIFER: These are amendments, the last amendments are amendments to that amendment.

PRESIDENT: All right, you want to reject the amendments.... well, you could just withdraw it.

SENATOR RICHENDIFER: Withdraw the amendments on page 520.

PRESIDENT: All right, Senator Richendifer is asking to withdraw the amendments on page 520 of the Legislative Journal. I wonder if there are objections to that? If not, so ordered. They're withdrawn. Now, Senator Richendifer, back to you.

SENATOR RICHENDIFER: I move we adopt the amendments to the amendments found on page 662 and what this does, it gives the people out where they make these license plates about a year or two to plan a bi-centennial plate. What the entire amendment does is describe the plate the bi-centennial commission desires to have. Now, the reason for the amendment to the amendment is the fact that on the farm plates, on the truck plates, they cannot follow these regulations in it.
